COLOUR.... Mid-amber with pale gold highlights.

NOSE..... Quite light and delicate with a toasty, slightly charred note; water brings out a little Olde English marmalade note, some lime, cumin, geranium and basil with a little Sherry rubber aroma and some sultanas

PALATE.... Drier than the Original, with oak flavours of vanilla, cream, leather, coffee, rich toffee and some spice.....

FINISH..... Long, clean, spicy and tangy, rather like a Manzanilla Sherry.....

SWEETNESS..... 3 PEATINESS..... 2 PRICE..... 2

NOTES..... Dob. Tasted at Glenmorangie House at Cadboll with Annabel Meikle, the company's Sensory Whisky Creator. A new vatting to replace the old Sherry Finish. This seems drier than I remember its predecessor, but interesting nonetheless
